Synopsis:

Dr. Vincent Prestipino received his dental degree in 1979 from the University of Maryland and completed his postgraduate education in Prosthodontics in 1988 at New York University. He maintains a private practice in Bethesda, Maryland providing prosthetic and implant dentistry. He was a Clinical Assistant Professor at the University of Maryland Dental College from 1997 to 2000..
